



Camden Michael Spencer

June 23, 1982 - September 21, 2021

Camden Michael Spencer, a long-time Truckee, CA resident and fifth-generation native Nevadan died on September 21, 2021 in Chewelah, WA. He was 39.

Spencer was born June 23, 1982 in Reno, NV to Michael and Danna Spencer and grew up in Fallon NV, graduating from Churchill County High School in 2000. He played varsity football for the Fallon Greenwave and was a member of the Greenhead Hunting Club there.

Spencer owned and operated Alpine Steel, based in Truckee. His company specialized in water delivery systems for snow-making operations at Western ski resorts as well as residential and commercial construction. Eric Balken, General Manager of 49 Degrees North resort said, "Camden was the consummate professional. He embodied it, he lived it. And he cared about all the people around him. He went about his work in a way that showed these things."

Spencer was an avid outdoorsman skiing & boarding, boating, hunting, snowmobiling and back-country camping. He was a passionate fan of the San Francisco Giants.

Spencer is survived by his long-time companion Trudy Ciaruffoli of Truckee, his parents, Mike and Danna Spencer of Reno; sister Alanna Spencer of Oakland, CA, Grandmother Nita Kirn of Sparks, NV; Uncle Dennis Kirn of Reno, Aunt Kim Lattin of Reno and numerous cousins.

A private service and celebration of life is being held on Friday, October 1st.
