Marinus (Ren) Albert Reugebrink suddenly passed away Monday afternoon July 31, 2023, at the age of 79 in Truckee, California doing what he loved - wrenching on vehicles. He held NASCAR records (West Coast Series) and would enthusiastically discuss cars whenever given the chance. Ren's

warm smile and kind demeanor made him a respected figure in his community, always ready to lend a helping hand to anyone in need. Throughout the years, Ren cherished his dogs, and his current companion, Bailey, now misses him dearly. Ren's love for his family was immeasurable, and he was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend. Proud of his Dutch heritage, he tried to keep up with the language, teaching his family about the culture while always planning to visit Holland again one day. Those who knew him often described Ren as a true class act, and his absence will be deeply felt by many. There will be a celebration of life and details furth coming.
