



## Ronnie Kevin Conston

November 21, 1965 - April 26, 2018

Ronnie Kevin Conston passed away unexpectedly at home on April 26, 2018 in Truckee, California at the age of 52.

Ronnie is survived by his sisters, Shirley Priestley, of Oakland, California and Glenda Conston, of Napa, California; his brother, Brian Conston, of San Diego, California; and his niece, Courtney Marve Conston-Chism, of Dallas, Texas and a large extended family in California, Texas and Louisiana. His parents, Germon “Tiny” and Muriel, and his brother Marvin precede him in death.

Ronnie was born at Tahoe Forest Hospital on November 21, 1965 in Truckee, California to Germon Conston Jr. and Muriel Marve’ Conston.
